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North Georgia Community YMCA Receives \$5,000 Donation from Publix .

[Chattanooga, Tenn., February 25, 2022] – The North Georgia Community YMCA recently received a \$5,000 donation from Publix Super Markets Charities for its Backpack Blessings Program.

The Backpack Blessings program provides nutritious, non-perishable food items to students each Friday to reduce weekend huger and help students prepare for Monday's learning in the classroom. The program is supported through a partnership with schools, volunteers, grants and individual donors, serving children throughout Walker and Catoosa Counties each school year.

In 2021, the YMCA of Metropolitan Chattanooga prepared and served 575,532 meals across 80 area sites. During 2021, the Backpack Blessings Program in North Georgia, prepared 9,112 healthy meals, engaging 167 volunteers.
