ITINERARY

Day 1:

Board a spacious, restroom & video equipped Motorcoach and set off for Vermont. Tonight, you'll check into an en route hotel for a good night's rest.

Next, head downtown to Burlington's Church Street Marketplace. This award-winning open air mall is a hub of activity where you'll find architecture and over 100 places to shop and dine. Tonight, enjoy a scenic dinner cruise on beautiful Lake Champlain, complete with entertainment and dance floor.

Day 5:

After enjoying Continental Breakfast, you'll head on a guided tour of the spectacular Rock of Ages Granite Quarry - the world's largest granite quarry. At the Craftsmen Center, you'll watch talented sculptors transform granite into life-like statuary. Then, visit Montpelier, the State Capitol of Vermont, and take an informative tour. This afternoon, enjoy a fun tour of the Morse Farm Sugar Works. Here, you'll see how real Vermont Maple Syrup is made from the tree to your table. Your visit also includes "Sugar & Snow" experience. Tonight, enjoy a dinner party with entertainment.

Day 6:

After a Continental Breakfast, you'll take a scenic drive to the Cold Hollow Cider Mill, one of the leading New England producers of fresh apple cider. Enjoy a taste of fresh cider while learning how it's made. Then, visit Stowe Village, a charming New England village. Later, tour the world-famous Ben & Jerry's Ice Cream Factory, nestled in Vermont's Green Mountains. This evening, you'll dine at a local restaurant.
