ITINERARY

Day 1:

Your trip begins with an overnight flight passing over Scotland and the rolling country side of Wales.

Day 2:

Your journey opens in the capital of Scotland, Edinburgh where you will see history around every corner. Discover Scotland's rocky hill and the medieval crossroads. This evening join other travelers for a welcome dinner that highlights the flavors of Scotland (Dinner provided).

Day 3:

The day is yours! Take a locally guided tour to get acquainted with the city via coach **OR** join a local guided tour and see the city on foot. Both tours include visits to Edinburgh Castle, home to the Scottish Crown Jewels, and the Palace of Holyroodhouse (the Queen's official Edinburgh residence, also former home of Mary, Queen of Scots). The rest of the day is yours to spend how you would like (Breakfast provided).

Day 4:

Today you will travel south through Borders Region stopping to visit the archeological site of Vindolanda, an Ancient Roman fortress built along Hadrian's Wall in the 2nd century. You will then arrive in the medieval city of York where you will enjoy a brief orientation tour and then stay the night within the historic walled section of the city (Breakfast provided).

Day 5:

Enjoy a leisurely morning exploring York at your own pace. Take in views of the labyrinths of quaint, the narrow streets that locals call Snickelways, or visit the city's famous Minster. End the day in Chester, where you will stay the next two nights, known for ancient walls enclosing charming Tudor and Victorian houses (Breakfast & Dinner provided).

Day 6:

Today, embark on a panoramic city tour and walk through Chester's Rows. You will discovery the city's hidden secrets, going in and out of the iconic 2-tiered shopping galleries with a local guide. Cross into Wales and see Llangollen, one of the country's most picturesque villages. Enjoy some free time in town before a traditional afternoon tea (Breakfast provided).

Day 7:

Step back in time on a journey through the English countryside to Stratford-upon-Avon. This afternoon visit the Bard's birthplace, the childhood home of William Shakespeare. After touring the home, enjoy time at leisure to explore. Join your fellow travelers for dinner this evening (Breakfast & Dinner provided).

Day 8:

Bid adieu to Stratford and travel to the charming university city of Oxford. Today you have the choice to take a traditional punting boat experience **OR** take a walking guided tour of the city passing places such as the colleges used to film Harry Potter. You will continue on to London, England's capital city (Breakfast provided).

Day 9:

You will take in the sites of London on a panoramic city tour, places like the Tower of London, Big Ben, the House of Parliament, Westminster Abbey, and the Royal Buckingham Palace. The day is yours to explore the city as you wish! This evening, toast to the end of a wonderful journey during a farewell dinner at a local restaurant (Breakfast & Dinner provided).

Day 10:

Depart for home and wish Britian a farewell as your journey ends (Breakfast provided).
