ITINERARY

Day 1:

Aloha! Your adventure begins on the sun-drenched beaches of Waikiki. Relax and "hang loose" before meeting your group tomorrow.

Day 2:

Today you will visit the World War II Valor in the Pacific National Monument, viewing artifacts and a short documentary on the "Day of Infamy." Next you will view USS Arizona Memorial, honoring those who lost their lives in the Pearl Harbor attack. After, tour Honolulu's sites such as the historic Iolani Palace, the state capital building, King Kamehameha's statue, and the National Cemetery of the Pacific. The rest of the day is yours (Breakfast & Dinner provided)

Day 3:

Start the day by jumping right into Hawaiian history with a visit to Iolani Palace to learn about the Hawaiian monarchs and the takeover of Hawaii by the United States. Then enjoy free time in downtown Honolulu. Later stop at the Pali lookout in O'ahu's rainforest before returning to Waikiki for an evening at your leisure (Breakfast provided).

Day 4:

Today you will board your flight to the volcanic "Big Island" of Hawaii and leave cosmopolitan O'ahu behind. The Big Island is larger than all the other islands combined and also famous for its volcanoes. Take in sights like Rainbow Falls before exploring Hilo on your own for lunch. Next tour the South Coast visiting inside Hawaii Volcanoes National Park. Walk along steam bluffs to view impressive caldera. Visit Kealahou Bay and one of the iconic black sand beaches before heading back to the hotel (Breakfast provided).

Day 5:

Enjoy a leisurely morning relaxing at your resort and look out over Big Island's rocky coastline. This afternoon you will enter into Kailua-Kona where you will have time to explore shops and grab lunch on your own before returning to the hotel for a lei making class taught by local experts. Learn about their cultural significance and create one to bring home (Breakfast provided).

Day 6:

Start your day at Bay View Farm, a coffee bean farm, where you will enjoy a tour with a local before tasting a local brew. View St. Benedict's Painted Church, built in the 1800s and then continue to Pu'uuhonua o Honaunau National Historical Park on the rugged coast (Breakfast & Dinner provided).

Day 7:

Board an inter-island flight to the stunning "Valley isle" of Maui. Visit Iao Valley and view the 2,000 foot-high Iao Needle. Visit the old royal capital of Lahaina, once home to the world's largest whaling fleets. Travel through sugarcane fields to the resort area of Ka'anapali and arrive at your deluxe beachfront hotel (Breakfast & Dinner provided).

Day 8:

Today is a leisure day to see for yourself why locals say Maui no ka oi (Maui is the best). Perhaps you will take an optional cliff-side drive on the Road to Hana or explore the beaches, maybe shop for souvenirs or just relax. The options are endless! (Breakfast provided).

Day 9:

Wake up to another day in paradise! The day is yours to do as you will, possibly join a tour to visit Lahaina town to explore the former royal capital. Tonight, end your wonderful trip with a farewell dinner, Hawaiian-style, at a traditional Polynesian luau with endless tropical drinks and a sumptuous feast (Breakfast & Dinner provided).

Day 10:

Aloha to Hawaii as this memorable trip ends in Maui. Say farewell and journey home. (Breakfast provided).
