ITINERARY

Day 1:

Your journey begins in Fairbanks, Alaska a place that brings together the best of both sea and land. Tour Fairbanks and see what all it has to offer.

Day 2:

Start day two off by going aboard the Sternwheeler Discovery, highlighting Alaska's diverse culture and history. You will have the opportunity to meet people along the way and get a taste of local life. Take a scenic motor coach ride to Denali National Park and tonight enjoy a musical performance about the first brave men to summit Denali followed by dinner (Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner provided).

Day 3:

Today will start with travels deep into Denali National Park on the Tundra Wilderness Tour. Learn about the history of the park and see why Denali is one of the top three reasons that people visit Alaska. The rest of the day is yours to enjoy at your leisure (Breakfast provided).

Day 4:

Your day begins with a scenic train ride to Talkeetna aboard a luxury domed railcar. View the incredible landscape from the glass-ceiling and open-air observation platforms during this guided ride. Day 5:

Day 6:
