

ITINERARY

Day 1:

You're on your way for a true taste of southern Spain, from the sparkling blue waters of Costa del Sol to the chic avenues of Madrid. Your tour begins with an overnight flight.

Day 2:

Today you will arrive in Malaga, one of the oldest cities in Europe known for its Andalusian lifestyle and for being the birthplace of Pablo Picasso. Settle in and enjoy the town of Fuengirola. In the evening join your tour manager and fellow travelers for a welcome reception.

Day 3:

Start the day with a guided tour of the port city of Malaga by walking through the colorful market stalls and learn about the history and culture of this seaside community. Then it's your choice! Venture into the The Alcazaba and get to know the fortified palace with a local guide **OR** enter the Picasso Museum, and explore at your own pace many of the paintings by this iconic artist. Reconnect with your fellow travelers during lunch at a local's home. (Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner provided)

Day 4:

Today you will travel to Sentenil de las Bodegas, a town known for its whitewashed houses built into the cliffs. Setenil has a deep tie to the Arab population that once ruled the region. Enjoy time to explore on your own before heading to Ronda. Walk the Old Town and see its 18th-century Puente Nuevo over the El Tajo gorge. (Breakfast provided)

Day 5:

Journey to romantic Marbella today and enjoy a walking tour of the city's winding cobblestone streets before spending some free time to explore Marbella's charming shops, cafes, and galleries on your own. After, return to your hotel and spend the rest of the day at leisure, relaxing on the beach, or join an optional tour to Mijas. (Breakfast & Lunch provided)

Day 6:

Today you will travel to Granada and spend the morning with a local expert visiting Alhambra, a UNESCO World Heritage site also known as on of the Wonders of the Muslim world. Next enjoy some free time in Granada for lunch on your own before returning to Fuengirola for the evening. (Breakfast provided)

Day 7:

This morning say farewell to the Costa del Sol and hop on a northbound train to the capital city of Madrid. Next join a panoramic tour of the city's historic center. See iconic sites like the Gran Via and Puerta de Alcala and get a better sense of the layout of the city. Tonight, enjoy a traditional dinner with entertainment at a local restaurant. (Breakfast provided)

Day 8:

Today you will travel to Segovia and join a local guide for a tour about iconic Roman Aqueduct and historic Main Square. Next take a tour of the Alcazar de Segovia, an impressive castle, a museum and military archives. Enjoy lunch on your own before heading back to Madrid for a farewell dinner with fellow travelers. (Breakfast & Dinner provided)

Day 9:

Today after breakfast you will depart for home with your new friends and talk about your wonderful time you had in Spain.
